MULTIPLE ROUND ROBIN



FORMAT DESCRIPTION

This is a great format for mixed abilities and can be used with multiple-size courts/balls, or just one court size. Kids will play in their own round robin group. Based on results or random selection, players can be rearranged for additional rounds.

VARIATION

- Play timed matches or a set number of points.
- Effective with large groups.
- Helps get players of the same ability level grouped after the first round.
- Can have multiple round robin groups.


AGES

All ages welcome; recommended for 6 years old and up.

SETUP AND PLAY

- Below, two different round robin groups are using three courts each. Players rotate within their group.
- As the players rotate, a helper can move around with the kids to track scores.
- After the round robin is finished, the kids can be mixed up again, or moved according to how they finished in their groups.
- Below, the three top finishers from Group 1 move and play the three top finishers from Group 2.
